

Want to get a book from Thunder Bay?

Lakehead Orillia students have access to most of the resources that Thunder Bay students have.

If you want to have a book sent to Orillia from the Thunder Bay Paterson Library, or the Education Library, do the following:

1. Find a good book using the library catalogue.
2. When you're looking at the book's record, go to the REQUESTS tab.

3. Fill in your student number and last name on the next screen.
4. If the status says Available – you want to do a Callslip. If it says On Loan - you want to do a Recall and you will be put on a waiting list for the book.
5. On the last screen, where you see the book information, enter your student number again, choose ORILLIA as your pickup location, and click submit.
6. Unless you are being put on a waiting list, you'll have your book in about a week!

P.S. – this won't work for books kept in special collections, like the Gender Issues Centre, or the Thunder Bay reference section.
