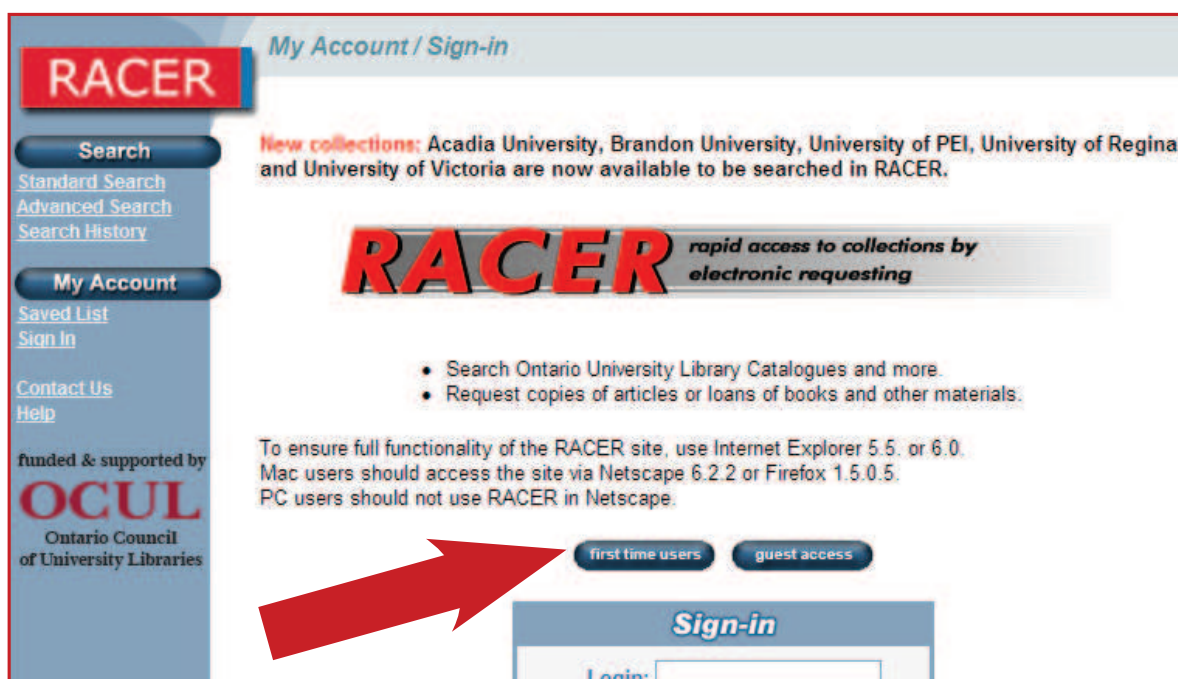


Know what RACER is?

You should – because it gives you free access to books from nearly all the universities in Ontario, including U of T, York, Western and Queens. And for \$2.00 you can get copies of journal articles that you can't find electronically or in print from the Thunder Bay library.

To use Racer:

1. Find the RACER link on the library homepage.
2. If it's your first time, register with the program (it only takes a minute – pick a password that you are going to remember, maybe the same as your Lakehead password).



3. When you do a book search, a long list of results will come up from all the different libraries that own the book. Choose the first one on the list that looks like it is the right book and edition and year.
4. Click **Get It**, and all the information for your request gets filled in automatically. You just have two important things to do:
 - Fill in the **Item not needed after date** – if your item turns out to be hard to get, this lets us know when we can stop searching for it.
 - At the very bottom, choose Lakehead Orillia as your **pickup location**.
